COPY DEADLINE/FORMAT

The copy deadline for all advertisements and editorial features is stated in the magazine. It is the responsibility of the Client to provide artwork which is accurate, legal and copyright free. Artwork designed by the Publisher must be signed off by the Client as accurate and legal. The Publisher takes no responsibility for loss or damage resulting in an advert being incorrect, having been signed off by the Client.

INVOICES AND PAYMENT

All invoices raised by the Publisher shall become due by the date shown on the invoice. Invoices which are overdue for a period in excess of 14 days from the invoice due date for any services will be subject to credit control procedures which may include the filing of a County Court Order.

CANCELLATION

Advertising space can be cancelled 10 days from the copy deadline of the issue for which it was booked. Late cancellation may result in full payment being levied on the Client.
